# Competencies: Knowledge of the Stations of the Path of Human Rights.

Trainers are familiar with the path and stations of human rights:

Historical stations / Context of human rights / Biographies (in Austria).

### Competencies: Historical Knowledge of the Era of Nationalism and Fascism.

Background of that time, places.

Mauthausen – Gusen: concentration camps, people living there.

Empoli: Brief history of deportations.

Use of historical material: description of stations, films, witness documentation.

## Competencies: Experiences with Human Rights and Children's Rights.

Personal perspective on human rights or own experiences in this area can be very useful, such as escape, discrimination, and ways out of it.

# Competencies: Methodological and Didactic Knowledge of Working with Disadvantaged Groups.

Materials include games, stories, and questions that are used with groups, especially. For historical content, there are audios in the Austrian Path of Human Rights.

Trainers choose methods depending on the groups.

Competencies: Building Networks with Other Individuals and Organizations.
